## News for 2008 Adequate Yearly Progress

- Failing retests are never included in AYP calculations.
- USED has approved Proxy Percentages for the Students with Disabilities subgroup again this year. If this subgroup does not meet the AMO, an additional 14% for English performance and 16% for Math performance will be added to passing rate and then compared to the AMO. If the Students with Disabilities subgroup met the AMO using Proxy Percentage, a "PP" code will be displayed on the AYP Detail Report, in the AMO Met ? column.
- All tests given in grades 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and End-of-Course subjects will be included in both Participation calculations (current and 3-year). They will also be included in the Performance calculation for the current, previous, and 3-year average.
- If neither the current nor 3-year average meet or exceed the performance AMO, Safe Harbor will be considered for the subgroup in question to make AYP. To best compare if the failure rate decreased by 10 % from the previous year, a passing rate consisting of tests given in grades 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and EOC will be compared to last year's passing rate. Last year's passing rate also includes grades 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 6, and EOC.
- Since students participating in a Recovery program in grades 4, 5, 6, and 7 take the grade appropriate SOL test, their scores will be included in AYP as they are first time test takers in that grade. 8<sup>th</sup> grade tests with a Recovery Flag will not be included as these students are re-taking the 8<sup>th</sup> grade test. EOC tests with a Recovery Flag will be included only if the student passes.
- Only AP and IB substitute tests are included in performance calculations. All other substitute tests will be counted against the participation rate.
- The NCLB Graduation Indicator will be used for safe harbor for all schools with a graduating class. Division level safe harbor will require meeting the AMO or showing improvement in both their chosen OAI and the NCLB Graduation Indicator.
- The AYP detail report and School Report Card will display the passage rates after the reassignment of any VAAP scores that have exceeded the 1% cap.
